Finally, a note on croups; a dropped croup does not translate into a better turn of stifle. It just makes it hard for the dog to drive off in the rear. Watch a video on good construction and you'll see what I mean.

DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE NOT JUST JACK** (Mulligan) Tri. Sweet expression with lovely round eyes, short backed, well broken, good movement. Good rear with a level tail set. Happy and attentive. Showed well.
- 2) **LINRICA OVER THE MOON BABY** (Liu) Bl. This boy had beautiful eyes, was short backed and a nice size. He was a little uncertain and needed more drive.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

- 1) **FALLING SPRINGS RAMBLIN GAMBLIN MAN** (Curley) Tri. This boy was a nice size with good bone. He had a lovely head and expression, a level topline and was well broken. He moved well.. **[BEST PUPPY DOG AND BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.](#)**

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (1)

- 1) **DARANE THE ONCE AND FUTURE KING** (Solino) Tri This puppy was full of beans. He had nice eyes and a beautiful coat. His tail was a bit high but with more training that could improve. A little narrow in the muzzle for me.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

- 1) **DREAMVALE NOT THAT KIND OF ANGEL** (Sage/Perini/Colbert) Bl. Full head, lots of cushioning, great topline, shorter body, good bone, short hocks, big dark eyes, fuller muzzle. Tail a bit high.
- 2) **ORCHARD HILL NEWS TO ME** (Venier/Venier). Dark eyes, lovely expression, longer cast, great pigment, more moderate, high tail as above. Hocks a bit high.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1) **PINNACLEE CHOCOLATE BUTTONS** (Norton) Gorgeous coat, full expression, round, dark eyes, nice bone, short backed, a little close behind. Best Ruby Dog in Show. Reserve Winners Do
- 2) **NIGHTINGALE WIPEOUT** (Mulligan) BL. Lovely head, a little longer cast, moderate bone, short hocks, moved well, full of beans. 1st Award of Merit
- 3) **COPPERHILL DOPPLER ON THE RADAR** (Mitchell/Mitchell) Tri Heavily marked, nice head but a bit plain, eyes round but a little small, needed to settle on table.
- 4) **CARLISLE'S ARCTIC ICE OF SOLHEIMAR** (Brynjarsdottir) Tri Round eyes, good topline, longer cast than #1, croup drops and chest could be fuller to hand.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN IM A BELIEVER** (Dingman) Bl. Lovely head, large eyes, well broken, short, good bone, nice coat, short backed, short hocks, nice movement.
- 2) **CHADWICK MELODRAMA** (Eckersley/McCarty) Bl. Heavily marked Blenheim, shorter style head, eyes were squinting - but seemed large. Similar type to above, great pigment, straight in rear.

HEALTH & CONFORMATION (1)

- 1) **CH CHADWICK SHOOTING UPWARDS OF CEILIMOR, C-TKN** (McCarty/Eckersley) Large Blenheim boy, lots of coat, heavily marked, full head, big, large eyes, nice pigment, nice cushioning, short hocks, moved well.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

- 1) **LOOK OUT SECRET AGENT MAN AT TYEWN** (Knauss/May) Lovely classic head with big, round eyes. Lovely pigment. Moderate all over and a nice size. Balanced front and rear with short hocks. Tail a bit high.
- 2) **CRANVARL WASHINGTON** (Sage/Crane) Fuller head, big round eyes, short backed, a little pudgy, lovely coat. Tail also a bit high.
- 3) **VERHEYEN BANJO ON MY KNEE OF CROWNROSE** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) Round dark eyes, well broken, longer cast, a bit gawky stifle was a bit straight.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI DOG (1)

- 1) **NORTHPOINTE ON SAFARI** (Mitchum) Pleasant expression and nice round eyes, well broken, very animated. Balanced but not enough angles for me.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (2)

- 1) **JEWELCROFT EMBEE REMY MARTIN** (Calabrese/Squirrel) Heavy boned ruby with lovely round eyes, creases on head - not my preferred expression. Lovely pigment, lots of hair. Showed well.

- 2) **KALAIS MAKING IT RAIN** (Hess) had a hard time standing still. Lovely round eyes, cushioning, nice pigment, nice shape, look forward to seeing him older and more settled.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK & TAN DOG (4)

- 1) **DREAMVALE GENTLEMAN JACK** (Slusher/Slusher/Smith) B/T Full muzzle and lovely round eyes. Solid construction and good movement. Short backed. Lovely bone.
- 2) **REGIS WILCAL JOEY** (Mitchell/Mitchell) B/T. Pleasing expression and round eyes. Adequate construction, coat. Croup dropped off.
- 3) **AUTUMNHILL SILVER JUBILEE, MP AW** (Parente/Woodward) Nice expression and round eyes, nice length, could be better balanced.
- 4) **CARLEN MYRDDIN WYLIT AT TYCWN** (Knauss/Close) Pleasant expression and lovely eyes. Well cushioned. Nice coat. Rear could be stronger.

OPEN DOG (3)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL ARISTOCRAT** (Venier/Venier) Bl. A real toy dog in fabulous condition. Lovely expression with large round eyes. Good bone for size, good angulation front and rear. Moved very well. **WINNERS DOG, BEST IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED, BEST BLENHEIM, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR**
- 2) **CH CODE BLACK OF CEILIMOR, C-TDN** (Eckersley/McCarty) Tri. Lovely head and big round eyes. Well coated and bone for size. Nicely marked, Moved well. **BEST TRI DOG, 2nd AWARD OF MERIT**
- 3) **CH FOXWYN REVOLUTIONARY** (Dingman/Fox) Bl. Nice head, Moderate, cushioning, well broken, moved well. Topline could be straighter.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

- 1) **CH. CHANTISMERE CAST A SPELL ON CORDUKE** (Mulligan) Bl 12 year old, lovely balanced Blenheim, well angulated, classic head type, nice eyes, cushioning, nice tail set, short hocks.
- 2) **BLACKFIRE SIMPLE TWIST OF FATE** (McLaughlin/Weidig/Kennedy/Kennedy) 10 year old, cute b/t, lovely coat, looks like a puppy, lovely eyes, nice bone/size, rear could be better.

BITCH CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **KRYSTAL DREAMVALE KEEPING SECRETS** (Sage) Tri. Sweet face, good bone, nice coat, dark, round eyes, very good rear movement, well balanced **BEST PUPPY BITCH & BEST TRI BITCH.**
- 2) **TUDORR GIGI** (Mixon/Mixon) Bl. A pretty Blenheim with a pleasing expression, nice cushioning. Slightly longer cast than #1. Good movement.
- 3) **AUTUMN HILL SOME LIKE IT HOT** (Parente/Green) Ruby. Lovely expression with big dark eyes, good topline, balanced. Plugged in.

- 4) **DARANE PEARLY WHITES** (Bronowicka/Carter) Tri. Pleasing expression with round eyes. Nice size. Heavily marked. Not the rear of the others. Skull could be flatter.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **CHADWICK JABOT** (Eckersley) Bl. Sweet face with round eyes. Nice cushioning. Nice pigment, well broken. Good top on the move.
- 2) **SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE** (Green) Bl. Elegant toy spaniel who was very cute and great big eyes. Short backed. She was a bit anxious and held her tail down. I look forward to seeing her again when she is more confident.
- 3) **CHADWICK STARBURST OF SUMJAYS** (Eckersley/Hellman) Tri. Pretty head, round eyes, good bone, good top on move, heavy marked.
- 4) **CHADWICK POETRY** (Eckersley) Bl. This pretty girl had lovely eyes. She was well broken but hard to assess. She kept sitting down. Her rear could have been stronger.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL PRETTY CLOSE** (Venier/Venier) Bl. This girl had a gorgeous head and eyes with dark, black, rims. She was a true toy spaniel. She was a nice length, a lovely bend of stifle, was well presented and moved out.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH

- 2) **CHADWICK PICTURE PERFECT** (Eckersley) Bl. Also had a nice head with lovely cushioning and pigment. She was short backed and had lots of hair. She was a little heavier than #1. Sweet temperament.
- 3) **SHERAH SILK STOCKINGS** (Crommett) Tri Nice overall shape and expression. Nice round eyes. Good bone for size. Her croup dropped a bit.
- 4) **TRUELEGANCE MOONLIGHT RHAPSODY** (Cromer/Cromer) Round eyes. Longer cast than above. Heavily marked. Rear could be stronger.

NOVICE BITCH (3)

- 1) **ISLEPOSEA WONDERLUST** (Hoehn) Bl. Very pretty. Lovely expression, large round eyes, black pigment. A little heavily marked. Nice top, tailset, Nice bone for size. Moved well.
- 2) **JEMANDA PRINCESS LEIA** (Weinstein) Larger frame, big round head, lovely front, rear not as angled. Sweet personality.
- 3) **LYNSFAIRE LOVE OF MY LIFE** (Fairchild) Tri Round eyes. Well broken. Nice front. Rear could have had more angulation. A bit shy.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

- 1) **CH CARLEN CHATEAU STE MICHELLE, JW, AW** (Close) Ruby. Romantic and sweet ruby girl. Pretty coat. Big round eyes. Lovely color. Balanced. A bit high in the rear. **BEST RUBY BITCH.**

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (2)

- 1) **SHADY GROVE ACRES' PRINCESS KALIA OF SOLHEIMAR** (Brynjarsdottir) Bl. Petite Blenheim. Very pretty expression. Short coupled. Needs a bit more angulation in front.
- 2) **WELMFORTH ANGEL IN DISGUISE** (Lasser) Bl. Pretty head with more bone than one. Big dark eyes, lovely cushioning and nice pigment. Well broken, nice coat, needs better self carriage.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

- 1) **TUDORR QUIETLY MAKING NOISE AT AMMIK** (Mixon/Madden) Bl. A lovely toy spaniel. Very sweet head with nice cushioning and pigment. Nice shape, well broken, well presented, good bone to size, nice package. **FIRST AWARD OF MERIT**
- 2) **FIELDSEGE INEFFABLE** (Slusher) Bl. Nice expression and nice eyes. Good outline. Well angulated front and rear. A bit shy. Needs training.
- 3) **SHERAH A STAR IS BORN** (Crommett) Bl. Another sweet face, eye pigment. Nice outline, shape, coat.
- 4) **NORTHPOINTE CHANGE THE WORLD ONE SEQUIN** (Mitchum) Bl. Sweet expression. Heavily marked. Longer coat. Nice character. Topline could be stronger.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (6)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL HIGH DRAMA** (Venier/Venier). Very pretty with large dark eyes. Lovely black rims, good cushioning, Good pigment, nice shape and bone to size. Well broken. Nice topline. Moved well. Happy and Confident. **BEST OPPOSITE SEX, WINNERS BITCH, BEST AMERICAN BRED, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR, BEST BLENHEIM.**
- 2) **BLUEGARDEN FINAL EDITION OF CHARDOMONT** (Greak/Comer) Bl. Larger and longer cast. Head similar to above but furrowed. Solid. Moved well.
- 3) **ROCKCREEK EXCUSE ME BOYS AT DULCE** (Covell) Sweet expression and temperament. Smaller. Short backed. Moderate all over. Not as much coat. A nice package.
- 4) **KRYSTLE ITS ALL ABOUT AMY** (Torgersen/Torgersen) Larger girl with a lovely expression. Balanced. Nice topline. Croup was a bit steep.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI BITCH (6)

- 1) **CHADWICK PURPLE PASSION** (Greak/Comer/Ekersley) Tri. Large round eyes. Short backed. A little big. Nice bone for size. Needs coat.
- 2) **AUTUMN HILL SUMARA WALK THE LINE** (Gentil/Parente) Tri. Smaller eyes than above. Good front. Nice movement. Nice size. Slept on table.
- 3) **CROWNROSE SKY FULL OF SONG** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) Pretty expression. nice shape and size. Front angulation could be stronger.
- 4) **MELK ABBEYTITANIA BRING ON THE BLING FOR LOLA GRAY** (Watkins/Melia) Pretty expression. Nice outline. Good bone to size. Front angulation could be stronger.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK & TAN BITCH (1)

- 1) Hytea Puddle Jump of Chardomont (Greak/Comer) B/T. Pretty head with shorter muzzle. A little heavy. Solidly built with a compact frame. **BEST BLACK & TAN BITCH, BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW**

OPEN BITCH (6)

- 1) **ISLEPOSEA WHISK ME AWAY** (Hoehn) Bl. Classic head with large eyes, dark rims, great pigment and cushioning. Nice topline. Nice package. Balanced. **2ND AWARD OF MERIT.**
- 2) **NIGHTINGALE OVER THE TOP, JW** (Mulligan) Bl. Bl Pretty head and eyes with dark rims. Muzzle a bit shorter. Nice package. Good construction. Well broken.
- 3) **FIELDSEGE NAMASTE** (Smith/Slusher/Slusher) Bl Nice head, dark eye rims. Nice outline. High on leg. Muzzle could be fuller.
- 4) **CHADWICK FLYING ON CLOUD NINE** (Comer/Greak/Eckersley) Nice head with cushioning. Muzzle a bit short for me. Longer cast than above. Higher in hock.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (2)

- 1) **DREAMVALE HANDS DOWN** (Sage) Bl. Great big dark eyes, rims, full of beans, nice angulation and shape. Good bone for size. 12 years
- 2) **BLACKFIRE I APPROVE THIS MESSAGE** (Weidig/Kennedy/McLaughlin) Bl Eyes round and dark, similar shape, up on leg, well broken.

VETERAN DOG (1)

- 1) **CH CHANTISMERE CAST A SPELL ON CORDUKE** (Mulligan) See critique above in Senior Open Dog.

VETERAN BITCH
