Lovely head with large dark eyes, dark nose pigment and desired soft expression. good reach of neck, nice in outline, very nicely presented in beautiful coat and condition, moved very happily soundly and freely with balance, very outgoing personality. - 2. CEILIMOR DRESS CODE (McCarty) Blenheim puppy with nice rich well-defined markings, good overall structure and size with good front and rear construction, good head with nice dark eye and dark nose pigment, happy and outgoing he moved soundly, didn't have the finish of the class winner, needs to mature and coat up and settle when showing.
- **3. BROOKHAVEN AMERICAN PIE (Gregory/Ayers)** Ruby dog of correct size and type, overall construction and shape, nice coat and condition, good head, nice dark eyes and good nose pigment, a little bit unsure of himself at times he tended to carry his tail low, moved happily but needs to gain confidence. *BEST RUBY DOG*
- 4. SARAFAYE YOU'RE THE TOP (Lapidus) Blenheim puppy with nice head and dark eyes, well defined rich chestnut markings, good overall shape although tail set a little low which spoiled his outline at times, happy on the move, needs to mature and tighten in movement.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1. NORTHPOINT LETS START A REVOLUTION (Mitchum) Blenheim puppy of very nice shape, size and type with good overall construction front and rear, lovely reach of neck, nice in profile and on the stand, nice head and expression with dark eyes and nose pigment, well defined rich chestnut

markings, shown in very nice coat and condition, very happy and outgoing on the move moving soundly and positively, nice puppy overall.

- 2. CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley) Another nice blenheim of good size, shape and type, with well broken rich chestnut markings with desired lozenge, nice head with dark eyes, shown in good coat and condition, nice in profile and outline with correct front and rear construction, showed and moved happily with good topline.
- 3. **KENJOCKETY SILVER KISS (Weber) Blenheim** dog with well-defined rich chestnut markings, nice overall construction front and rear, nice dark eyes and nose pigment, not as mature in head as the first two class placings, needs to tighten in movement, coat a little on the blow today, will improve with time.
- 4. **AUTUMN HILL AMERICA'S TEAM (Parente/Green)** Black and Tan dog with nice dark eye and good head, nice rich tan highlights, nice overall size with good reach of neck, shown in good coat and condition, good overall construction front and rear but drops off a little in topline on the move, needs to mature and gain confidence.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1. **RIVERLEIGH HOT OFF THE PRESSES, MP (Dingman)** Very smart blenheim dog with good personality and outgoing temperament, nice overall proportions, well constructed front and rear, attractive and happy on the stand, nice head and dark eyes, rich chestnut marking, nice coat and condition, very nice in outline, confident on the move, moved freely, happily and soundly, well-handled and very attentive to his handler at all times.
- 2. FIELDSEDGE BALDUR (Slusher) Blenheim dog of good overall type, good front and rear construction, nice rich well broken chestnut markings, nice head with dark eye and nice expression, nice in profile, shown in good coat and condition, happy on the stand, I would like to see a bit more confidence and positivity on the move.
- **3.** CARLEN TINY TIM TATER TOT (Close) Richly marked blenheim of good overall size and construction, nice head and expression with dark eyes, good coat and condition, would like to see more animation on the stand, moved well but lacked some confidence, a little immature compared to the first two placings, needs time.
- 4. GENTLE STAR UNFORGETTABLE DREAM (Gentil) Blenheim dog with very rich coat colour, strong masculine head with nice dark eyes, good in front and rear construction, good bone and outline, nice overall size, was not confident or happy on the day and dropped his head on the move which spoiled his chances of placing higher.

NOVICE DOG (2)

- 1. NIGHTINGALE HELLO GOODBYE (Mulligan) Blenheim dog of good size and type with welldefined markings, nice head for age but needs to fill in muzzle, nice dark eyes and nose pigment, good overall front and rear construction and proportions, nice on the stand, happy and alert, shown in nice coat and condition, moved freely, happily and soundly, will improve when he is fully mature.
- 2 DREAMVALE HOLLYWOOD NIGHTS (Sage/Perini) Black and Tan dog of very nice size and shape, good head with lovely dark eyes, rich tan highlights, nice overall construction both front and rear with good proportions, very unsure of himself on the table and did not do himself justice, moved freely and was nice in outline but lack of confidence spoiled his chances on the day.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

- 1. <u>LINRICA OMEGA CONSTELLATION</u> (Hsiung/Liu) Tricolour dog of lovely size and type, nice head with dark eyes and correct tan highlights, good construction both front and rear, nice hocks and shoulder placement, shown in lovely coat and condition, moved freely and soundly, very attentive to his handler at all times.
- 2. <u>BLUEGARDEN CASINO ROYALE, MP</u> (Matos/Di Bonaventure) Another very nice tricolor who was very close to my class winner, I was splitting hairs between the two, lovely coat and condition, lovely head and eyes framed by long ears, well-constructed, nice on the stand but in the final challenge he was a bit unsettled, moved freely and soundly.
- **3. DREAMVALE ALL THAT JAZZ (Sage/Colbert)** Blenheim dog of good size and type, well-defined markings, nice head, would prefer a slightly darker eye, nice construction both front and rear with good topline, moved freely and soundly.
- 4. LYNSFAIRE AND I LOVE HER (Fairchild) Blenheim dog with well broken rich chestnut markings, nice dark eyes, needs to mature and fill in muzzle, good front and rear construction, moved freely and happily, lacked the maturity and finish of the winners.

CLARMARIAN HEARTTHROB, JW (Young-May/Gogol) Richly marked blenheim dog of nice size and type, happy on the stand, lovely dark eyes and head framed by long ears, nice in outline, good construction front and rear, presented in nice coat and condition, moved happily and freely, would like to see more drive in hind quarters, will mature and improve with time.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. KRYSTLE BLUE PERSUASION AT SAINTBRIDES (Burkley/Torgersen) Blenheim dog of nice size with very good bone, well-defined markings, mature head with long ears and long flowing coat, very happy on the stand and attentive to his handler, good construction both front and rear, moved happily and soundly but was proud of his tail at times which spoiled the overall picture a little.

DREAMVALE RED HAIR N BLACK LEATHER (sage/Colbert) Ruby dog shown in nice coat and condition for age with good overall construction front and rear, very immature at present in both head and body, nice in outline on the stand, very happy and outgoing temperament, tail never stopped wagging, moved happily but needs to muscle up in movement, will improve with age.
