# TRICK DOG TITLE INFORMATION

CKCSC-USA Trick Dog titles are official CKCSC-USA titles listed on the dog's title record.

The processing fee for each title is \$25. Multiple titles for the same dog can be sent in together, each one will be processed in succession after each previous title has been added and printed.

Dogs must have CKCSC-USA Registration Number or a CKCSC-USA Performance Event number and the owner and handler must be a member in good standing with the CKCSC-USA to earn a title.

## 4 TRICK DOG TITLES -

- **NOVICE TRICK DOG (C-TKN)**

The dog performs 10 skills from the Novice list.

- **INTERMEDIATE TRICK DOG (C-TKI)**

The dog must have the Novice title, plus perform 10 Intermediate tricks.

- **ADVANCED TRICK DOG (C-TKA)**

The dog must have the Intermediate title, plus perform 5 tricks from the Advanced list.

- **TRICK DOG PERFORMER (C-TKP)**

In this title, handlers perform a short routine with at least 10 tricks previously learned.

**Tricks are not limited by the suggest list of Tricks. Handlers may submit their own trick with descriptions on their application.**

To apply for a Trick Dog Title, the CKCSC-USA Trick Dog application and the CKCSC-USA respective title application must be completed. Evaluations will be offered at CKCSC-USA events for all levels. Evaluations will be conducted by a member of the CKCSC-USA Performance Committee or a member on the show performance committee.

Due to the possible complexity of the Trick Dog Performer routine, the Trick Dog Performer application may be sent as a video to the Performance Committee for review by the designated Trick Dog Evaluators.

# LIST OF TRICKS

**Tricks are not limited by this following list. Handlers may submit their own trick with descriptions on their application.**

### **Novice Level Tricks (handlers may use a food/toy lure if needed. May use food/clicker reinforcers.)**

Balance beam (walk on a low board a few inches off floor)	Hold (3 seconds)
Bark on cue ("Speak")	Jump (thru a low hoop or over a low bar)
Crawl (dog on belly, crawls at least 5 feet)	Kennel up (go in crate, stay in until released)
Fetch it and give (ball, toy etc – bring to handler and release)	Kiss (point to cheek)
Get your _____. (Leash, brush, name of toy).	Paws up (2 front paws on a low stool or step)
Get in (gets in a box)	Push-ups (sit, down, sit, down, sit, down)
Get on (gets on low platform or step – 4 paws)	Shake hands
Hand signals (down, sit or come)	Spin in circle.
High Five	Touch it (hand or target stick)
	Tunnel (agility tunnel or child's tunnel)

### **Intermediate level Tricks (handlers may use a food/toy lure if needed. May use food/clicker reinforcers)**

Balance treat on nose or head (e.g. dog biscuit)

Carry (a basket)

Catch (soft toy, soft ball)

Crawl (dog on belly, crawls at least 5 feet-may use food or toy lure)

Fetch it (20 ft.)

Game (dog manipulates interactive canine game to get treat)

Go find (handler hides, dog goes and finds)

Go to your place (to bed/mat, crate from 10 fts)

Hand signals (sit, down, come, stand etc. 3 in a row)

Leg weave (weave around handler's legs)

Paws up (on handler's arm)

Pull a toy on a string or rope.

Push button on sound toy, toy piano, to turn on audiotape, etc.

Rollover

Shell game (find treat under 1 of 3 cups)

Sit pretty (sit up or sit w/head tilted)

Wave good-bye

Weave poles (6 weave poles) (may use food or toy lure for this trick)

Wobble board

## **Advanced level Tricks**

Back up (walk backwards)

Balance treat on nose, flip to eat when told "OK"

Barrel (roll with 2 paws, or stand on with 4)

Bow (as in "Take a bow")

Cover your eyes.

Cover-up with blanket.

Go find (handler hides, dog goes and finds)

Go hide (get under table)

Head down

Hide your head (under blanket, front arm over head)

Jump into handler's arms

Jump over handler's back

Light (turn on pressure sensitive battery operated light)

Open door of mailbox, toy refrigerator, get object.

Play dead.

Scent articles (choose from 5 – dog can 'read')

Sit or down at distance (15 ft)

Tissue out of box (and bring to handler)

Toys (take to and drop in box)

Weave poles (6 weave poles) (no food or toys lures)

The routine may have a story (e.g., "This is my dog Princess. Princess loves school-here's what she does at school. She plays ball on the playground, and then she takes a nap, " etc.
