GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

<u>Veteran, Puppy, and Adult Sweepstakes</u> take place on Friday morning at 9AM. Cash prizes are awarded to the winners. See Definition of Classes for eligibility. Please note the addition of Adult sweepstakes!

Scent Work Trials start at 2PM on Friday and 9AM Saturday and Sunday.

<u>Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match</u> will be held immediately following the lunch break all three days. Puppies at least 3 but not yet 5 months of age are eligible to compete. Puppy should be accustomed to a collar and lead or they may use a harness. This event is meant to be a good experience for the puppy rather than highly competitive. Puppy must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. Sign up at the show. Entry fee is \$5. (See Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match Rules in this premium for rules and eligibility.

<u>Vendors</u> Space will be available for 50\$ per table. Vendor tables will be in the foyer, directly outside the ballroom. Please contact the show chairs to reserve a table.

<u>Grooming Area</u> Will be available in a partitioned section of the ballroom.

<u>Junior Showmanship</u> has been enhanced to offer FOUR classes from which our young handlers can choose to participate. Wins earned in the new Intermediate Class count towards the Top Junior Showmanship Awards presented at the Annual Awards Banquet. The new Pee Wee Class is for youngsters from 5 years through 10 years of age and allows an adult to accompany them in the ring.

3/12/20 Scent Dog Trial Rules: Added effective 1/1/2021.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES CHANGE

3/12/20 Scent Dog Class Definitions: Added Scent Work Classes effective 1/1/2021.

5/12/22 Added new classes for Junior Showmanship and changed age eligibility for the Junior and Senior Class.

NEW JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES!

Effective 8/1/22, Junior Showmanship now offers four (4) classes for our young handlers that allows them to compete with others closer to their age. Participants can select to participate in only one class. (Refer to Class Definitions – Junior Showmanship for detail definitions.) To implement this change, the age ranges for the Junior and Senior Classes have been changed and two new classes are offered – Intermediate and Pee Wee Classes. Pee Wee Class participants can be 5 years of age and not yet 11 years of age and are allowed to have an adult in the ring. Wins in the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Classes count towards the Top Junior Showmanship Awards presented at the Annual Awards Banquet. Regardless of the class entered, a young handler can switch between Pee Wee and age eligible classes on a given day but can participate in only one of the four classes on any given day.

IMPORTANT!

<u>Supplemental Entry Form</u> and proof of foreign registration are required if you need to enter a dog using its Foreign Registry Number while you are waiting on a CKCSC number. Proof of foreign registration is any document that shows the foreign number is assigned to that dog. The application to register the individual dog or the litter must have been received by the Registration Office by late closing or the entry will not be accepted. If you have any questions or cannot download the form, please contact Beth Bales. (Refer to Show Rules Section II. Rule 1.)

<u>RINGSIDE READY REMINDER!</u> It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog ringside for all competitions for which they are eligible, including dogs that are eligible to return to the ring for Reserve and color specific competitions. The grooming area and hotel rooms are not ringside. Dogs that are not ringside and ready to enter when called to join the competition may not be allowed to enter the ring. (Refer to Show Rules Section I. Rule 21.)

TROPHY REMINDER!

<u>Any trophy unreturned</u> by the published start time of the show for which it is awarded is considered an automatic indebtedness and monetary penalties apply before you are allowed to show, whether you are in attendance or not. Refer to Show Rule I. Owners/Exhibitors – 5 for the complete text of the rule.

Trophies for Conformation must be returned by November 9th, engraved and polished, to the hotel or in person at the show. If you are not attending the show or are sending your trophy with another member, please have that person return the trophy directly to Leslie in time to for the trophy to be in the ballroom before the beginning of the show for which it is awarded. As of 9/1/22

The term "Dog" applies to both sexes unless otherwise specified.

CONFORMATION

As of 2/21/19

OFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(Championship Points awarded if entry justifies.)

Junior Puppy: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months.

Senior Puppy: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months.

Graduate Puppy: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

<u>Novice</u>: Dogs 5 months and older, never to have won any points at a CKCSC, USA, or CKCSC Regional Championship Show, nor a major win, nor a championship in any Registry in which the Breed is recognized.

Bred By Exhibitor: Dogs 5 months and older, owned by the breeder and handled in the ring by the breeder or his/her spouse or domestic partner. The breeder is the registered owner of the dam at the time of mating.

Junior American Bred : Dogs 5 months but not yet 18 months, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship if over 12 months of age.

American Bred: Dogs 18 months and older, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

<u>Health & Conformation</u>: Dogs 5 years of age and older with an OFA certificate that shows and OFA registry number and states that the dog has no evidence of hip dysplasia after 2 years of age and is certified clear within 1 year of the postmark closing date for that show of the following diseases: 1) Heart – by a board certified cardiologist; 2) Patellar Luxation – by a licensed veterinarian or via an OFA patella certificate; 3) Eyes – by CERF or by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist's exam sheet indicating that eyes are "normal". Copies of the 4 certificates must accompany the entry form for any dog entering this class.

<u>Special Limit Blenheim</u>: Blenheim dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. <u>Special Limit Tricolor</u>: Tricolor dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Ruby: Ruby dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Black & Tan: Black & Tan dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. Open: Dogs 5 months and older.

<u>Senior Open</u>: Dogs 7 years and older.

UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(No championship points awarded.)

<u>Veteran</u>: Dogs 7 years and older. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age. <u>Stud Dog:</u> Stud dogs to parade with 2 or more of their get from at least 2 different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership.

- Get must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of get only.
- <u>Brood Bitch</u>: Brood bitches to parade with two or more of their produce from at least two different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership. Produce must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of produce only.

<u>Brace</u>: Two dogs 5 months or older, of the same color and in the same ownership but not necessarily of the same sex. Class to be judged on similarity and quality.

FINAL AND SPECIAL AWARDS AWARDS

All official conformation classes are judged for dogs, then bitches. Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy competitions take place after judging concludes for that sex. Initial competition for Special Awards Best American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Blenheim, Tricolor, Ruby, and Black-and-Tan In Show is held after Best Puppy for that sex is awarded. Unofficial conformation classes, including Best Veteran In Show, are judged after the competition for Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy Bitch. The remaining Final and Special Awards follow the unofficial conformation classes.

FINAL AWARDS

(Championship points awarded if entry justifies.)

Winners (WD, WB) is awarded from the Class Winners.

<u>Reserve Winners</u> (RWD, RWB) is awarded from the remaining Class Winners and the second place dog to Winners. <u>Best Puppy</u> (BPD, BPB) is awarded from all undefeated puppies under one year of age after Reserve Winners and AOM's are awarded.

Best In Show (BIS) is awarded from Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

<u>Reserve Best In Show</u> (RBIS) is awarded from the Opposite Sex Winners and the Reserve Winners to Best In Show. <u>Best Puppy In Show</u> (BPIS) is awarded from the winners of Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy Bitch after Best In Show is awarded.

SPECIAL AWARDS

(No championship points awarded.)

<u>Best Veteran In Show</u> is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Classes immediately following the Veteran Class competition. <u>Best Health and Conformation In Show</u> is awarded from the winners of the Health and Conformation Classes immediately following the Best Black and Tan In Show competition. <u>Special Awards</u>: Awarded from eligible dogs from all of the classes. The definition for the Special Award is the same as the associated class definition. They must include:

- •Best American Bred in Show
- •Best Bred By Exhibitor In Show
- •Best Blenheim In Show
- •Best Tricolor In Show
- •Best Ruby In Show
- •Best Black-and-Tan In Show

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

(No Championship Points awarded.)

<u>Junior Puppy</u>: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title. <u>Senior Puppy</u>: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title. <u>Graduate Puppy</u>: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

ADULT SWEEPSTAKES As of 2/21/19

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Adult: Dogs 18 months but not yet 7 years and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES As of 2/21/19

(No Championship Points awarded.)

<u>Bronze Veteran</u>: Dogs 7 years but not yet 9 years. <u>Silver Veteran</u>: Dogs 9 years but not yet 11 years. <u>Gold Veteran</u>: Dogs 11 years and over.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP As of 8/1/22

(To be judged on how well the dogs are handled, NOT on the dogs themselves.)

<u>Pee Wee Class</u>: Handlers 5 years but not yet 11 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. Handler is allowed to have an adult accompany them in the ring. All participants are awarded first place ribbons. Wins are not eligible for yearend awards.

<u>Junior Class</u>: Handlers 6 years but not yet 10 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. <u>Intermediate Class</u>: Handlers 10 years but not yet 14 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table. <u>Senior Class</u>: Handlers 14 years but not yet 18 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table.

PERFORMANCE

SCENT WORK As of 1/1/21

OFFICIAL SCENT WORK CLASSES

(Qualifying scores earn legs toward Scent Work titles.)

Novice A: Open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, who have not completed a comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as a professional detection dog handler.

Novice B: Open to all dogs.

Advanced: Dogs who have earned the Novice title for that element.

Excellent: Dogs who have earned the Advanced title for that element.

Master: Dogs who have earned the Excellent title for that element.

AWARDS

To be awarded upon conclusion of the judging for the eligible classes.

FINAL AWARDS

Scent Work High In Trial (SWHIT) is available when two or more elements are offered for the trial. High In Trial will be awarded to the highest qualifying team at each level. A team must enter and qualify in all elements offered at that level to be eligible to compete for High In Trial. High In Trial awards will be recorded with the show results.
