IMPORTANT!

<u>Supplemental Entry Form</u> and proof of foreign registration are **required** if you need to enter a dog using its Foreign Registry Number while you are waiting on a CKCSC number. The application to register the individual dog or the litter **must have been received by the Registration Office** by late closing or the **entry will not be accepted**. COVID-19 ANNOUNCEMENT

<u>Health Clinics</u> are being offered on Saturday. Due to the popularity of the clinics and the limited time the doctors are available, advanced scheduling is STRONGLY recommended. Walk-ins will be accommodated for regular exams if space and time allow. All breeds are welcome.

Forms Available at the Table: Three-part forms for echos (OFA Advanced Cardiac) and eye exams.

-- OFA Basic Cardiac (auscultation only heart forms)

-- OFA CAER Eye Certification (eye forms)

Note: An OFA account is required to create the eye certification form specific to your dog before downloading it.

For appointments and information, contact Pat Winters at <u>pswinters@charter.net</u> or call (757) 238-2036. If no answer, please leave a message. Pat will return your call promptly.

- Eye: Conducted by Dr. Ann Bosiack-Hall from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm. <u>No dogs will be seen after that time</u>. Please arrive 20 minutes early for application of dilating eye drops and to fill out paperwork (provided). Actual examinations take 5 minutes or less per dog. Fee is \$50.
- Heart: Conducted by Dr. Jess Weidman from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm. No lubricant is placed on the dog for auscultation exam. Auscultations take 5 minutes per dog. Fee is \$45. Echocardiograms are being offered by appointment only and must be scheduled <u>at least one week in advance</u>. Echos take 15 minutes. Fee is \$210 (includes auscultation). *Please arrive 10 minutes early to fill out paperwork*. At the request of Dr. Weidman, <u>masks must be worn</u> and <u>no owners will be allowed in</u> <u>the room during the exam</u>.

<u>NOTE</u>: We should not be seeing dogs with known heart disease where the owners are looking for medication recommendations. There is not time for this type of case during a clinic, especially since the portable echo machine we have available does not generate a detailed report. You will just get the 3-part OFA Advanced Cardiac form with the results.

Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match will be held immediately following the lunch break all three days. Puppies 3 - 4 months of age are eligible to compete. Puppy should be accustomed to a collar and lead or they may use a harness. This event is meant to be a good experience for the puppy rather than highly competitive. Puppy must be current on all age appropriate vaccinations. Sign up at the show. Entry fee is \$5.

CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED FOR ENTRY FEES

Cavaliers of the South (COS) will accept credit cards for entry fees in addition to checks, but will <u>not</u> be accepting any credit card information with your show entry. COS has switched to a completely different method done entirely with PayPal.

On the Summary of Amounts Due, check the line below TOTAL ALL ITEMS where prompted to indicate that you authorize COS to send you an invoice via PayPal. There is a \$7 convenience fee to use a credit card for payment.

About a week before the show you will receive an email from <u>service@paypal.com</u> with subject Invoice from Cavaliers of the South. It will contain a link to your invoice.

Click on the link in the email and you go directly to your PayPal invoice. The invoice will identify Cavaliers of the South and treasurer Jim Utych. Enter your credit card number and amount into their secure website. No one sees or has access to your information. The payment goes directly into the Cavaliers of the South account at PayPal.

Do NOT submit any credit card information with your entries.

DO make sure that the email address on your show entry has the email address to which you wish the invoice to be sent.

SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED VIA FAX AND EMAIL

Cavaliers of the South (COS) will accept entries via email and fax in addition to postal mail under the following conditions. PLEASE read the instructions CAREFULLY. Entries will not be accepted until payment is received. DO NOT SEND ANY CREDIT CARD INFORMATION WITH YOUR ENTRIES.

- 1. Entries submitted by mail must include a check or payment is assumed to be via PayPal. Entries postmarked after the postmark closing date are considered late entries subject to the late fee.
- 2. Entries submitted by fax must be received by the postmark closing date. If paying by check, the mailed check must be postmarked by the postmark closing date. If any of the above conditions are not met, the entries are considered late entries and subject to the late fee.

CONFORMATION (As of 2/21/19)

Official Conformation Classes (Championship Points awarded if entry justifies.)

Junior Puppy: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months.

Senior Puppy: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months.

Graduate Puppy: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

<u>Novice:</u> Dogs 5 months and older, never to have won any points at a CKCSC, USA or CKCSC Regional Championship Show, nor a major win, nor a championship in any Registry in which the Breed is recognized.

- <u>Bred By Exhibitor:</u> Dogs 5 months and older, owned by the breeder and handled in the ring by the breeder or his/her spouse or domestic partner. The breeder is the registered owner of the dam at the time of mating.
- Junior American Bred: Dogs 5 months but not yet 18 months, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship if over 12 months of age.
- <u>American Bred:</u> Dogs 18 months and older, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.
- Second Generation American Bred: Dogs 5 months and older which are American Bred and of which both sire and dam are American Bred, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. (Offered at the National Specialty, Members Club Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)
- <u>Health & Conformation</u>: Dogs 5 years and older with an OFA certificate that shows an OFA registry number and states that the dog has not evidence of hip displaysia after 2 years of age and certified clear within 1 year of the postmark closing date for that show of the following diseases: Heart - by a board certified cardiologist; Patellar Luxation - by a licensed veterinarian or via an OFA certificate; Eyes - by CERF of by a board certified veterinary opthalmologist's exam sheet indicating that the eyes are "normal". Copies of the 4
- certificates must accompany the entry form for any dog entering this class.

<u>Special Limit Blenheim:</u> Blenheim dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. <u>Special Limit Tricolor:</u> Tricolor dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. <u>Special Limit Ruby:</u> Ruby dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Black & Tan: Black & Tan dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Open: Dogs 5 months and older.

Senior Open: Dogs 7 years and older.

Unofficial Conformation Classes (No championship points awarded.)

Veteran: Dogs 7 years and older.

Stud Dog: Stud dogs to parade with 2 or more of their get from at least 2 different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership. Get must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. CLASS TO BE JUDGED ON QUALITY AND CONSISTENCY OF GET ONLY.

<u>Brood Bitch:</u> Brood bitches to parade with two or more of their produce from at least two different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership. Produce must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. CLASS TO BE JUDGED ON QUALITY AND CONSISTENCY OF PRODUCE ONLY.

<u>Brace:</u> Two dogs 5 months or older, of the same color and in the same ownership but not necessarily of the same sex. CLASS TO BE JUDGED ON SIMILARITY AND QUALITY.

Awards

All official conformation classes are judged for dogs, then bitches. Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy competitions take place after judging concludes for that sex. Initial competition for Special Awards Best Blenheim, Tricolor, Ruby, and Black-and-Tan In Show is held after Best Puppy for that sex is awarded. Unofficial conformation classes, including Best Veteran In Show, are judged after the competition for Winners/Reserve Winners Bitch/Best Puppy Bitch. The remaining Final and Special Awards follow the unofficial conformation classes.

Final Awards (Championship points awarded if entry justifies.)

Winners (WD, WB): Awarded from the Class Winners.

Reserve Winners (RWD, RWB): Awarded from the remaining Class Winners and the second place dog to Winners.

Best Puppy (BPD, BPB): Awarded from eligible puppies under 12 months of age.

Best In Show (BIS): Awarded from Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

Reserved Best In Show (RBIS): Awarded from the Opposite Sex Winner and the Reserve Winner to Best In Show.

<u>Best Puppy In Show (BPIS)</u>: Awarded from the winners of the Best Puppy Dog/Bitch competitions after Reserve Best In Show competition.

<u>Award of Merit</u> (AOM): Awarded after Reserve Winners from the remaining Class Winners and next placing dog to Reserve Winners or the first AOM winner. (Up to two AOM's are awarded to each sex at all National shows and each Regional AGM trophy show.)

Special Awards (*No championship points awarded.*)

Best Veteran In Show: Awarded from the winners of the Veteran Classes immediately following the Veteran Class competition. Special Awards: Awarded from eligible dogs from all of the classes. The definition for the Special Award is the same as the associated

class definition. They must include:

Best American Bred in Show Best Bred By Exhibitor In Show Best Health and Conformation In Show (from the Class Winners) Best Blenheim In Show Best Tricolor In Show Best Ruby In Show Best Black-and-Tan In Show

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES As of 2/21/19 (No Championship Points awarded.)

<u>Bronze</u>: Dogs 7 years, but not yet 9 years. <u>Silver</u>: Dogs 9 years, but not yet 11 years. <u>Gold</u>: Dogs 11 years and older.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES (No Championship Points awarded.)

<u>Junior Puppy</u>: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months and not holding a CKCSC,USA, championship title. <u>Senior Puppy</u>: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title. <u>Graduate Puppy</u>: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

<u>IUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP</u> (To be judged on how well the dogs are handled, NOT on the dogs themselves.)

<u>Junior Class</u>: Handlers 6 years but not yet 12 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. <u>Senior Class</u>: Handlers 12 years but not yet 17 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table.

CAVALIER KING CHARLES SPANIEL CLUB, USA, MATCH RULES as of 9/1/19

PEE WEE PUPPY

as of 9/1/19

(The term "Puppy" applies to both sexes unless otherwise specified.)

- 1. Where applicable, the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, (CKCSC, USA) "Procedure for Registration and Transfer of Dogs" and "Show Rules" will be followed.
- 2. CKCSC, USA, Members can show any Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy that is registered with or awaiting registration with the CKCSC, USA; has a Performance Event Number (PEN); or is ineligible for registration with the CKCSC, USA. Any non-member is welcome to enter their Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy.
- 3. No puppy may be entered under a Judge by whom it was bred or to whom it currently or has previously belonged, including coownerships.
- 4. <u>No</u> Championship Points shall be earned at Pee Wee Puppy Matches.
- 5. A single class will be offered for puppies at least three (3) months of age, but not yet five (5) months. Best Pee Wee Puppy will be awarded to the class winner. Puppies of the opposite sex to the winner will compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best Pee Wee Puppy. Critiques will be written for both winners.
- 6. Puppies must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. This is the owner's responsibility. By entering the competition, the owner acknowledges that the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, Inc., assumes no liability for any illness contracted by the puppy as a result of entering the competition.
- 7. A puppy may be shown on a collar and leash or harness.

Pandemic Planning Suggested Best Practices for the Well-Being of CKCSC Show Participants

as of 9/3/2021

The Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, has adopted the following appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. The Cavaliers of the South Winter Specialty weekend will follow these precautions and will be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of their participants and event officials.

Event locations, facilities and dates and requirements will differ. With a situation that is continually evolving, it is up to the Regional club to determine the guidelines that best fit their event. In order to inform participants, specific guidelines established by the National and Regional Clubs should be published in the premium, show catalog, club website and posted on signage/flyers for each event.

- 1. Club officials and participants are required to follow Club's Covid-19 policy as well as the current federal, state, local government, facility and event guidelines for the show on any given day.
- 2. Do not travel to the show if you, your family members or co-workers are ill.
- 3. Each exhibitor and attendee should have a personal mask available and properly wear it while in the ballroom or grooming areas at the national show.
- 4. Only Table Stewards, Ring Stewards, Judges and the Announcer will be allowed at the front table.
- 5. A CKCSC USA Covid-19 waiver will be signed at the show by each participant.
- 6. Noncompliance could result in being excused from the show grounds and forfeiting your entry fees and expenses.

Vendor Best Practices

- 1. Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the show location.
- 2. Vendors will provide sanitizer for their table
- 3. Vendor Tables should have adequate spacing between each vendor.
- 4. Patrons should follow the guidelines established by each vendor when interacting with that vendor.
- 5. Vendors should encourage social distancing at their tables

Exhibitors

- 1. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks.
- 2. Be respectful and compliant to all safety requests made by the judges and show committee.
- 3. Practice social distancing.

Win Photos

- 1. Congregation around the photo table is strongly discouraged. Only the photographer, judge, exhibitor and one helper may be in the photo area at one time.
- Each major winner will be allotted 15 minutes for their photo. The photo schedule will be determined by the award. Photos will begin 15 minutes after the Best In Show award ring parade. Photo time for multiple award winners is determined by their highest major award.
