5/16/24 Show Rule I. Owner/Exhibitors - 13: Cavaliers entered in Bred By Exhibitor may be moved to Open if the breeder/owner is unavailable to show the dog. Restrictions apply. Form is required. Other ineligible entries are no longer allowed to move to Open and must be withdrawn.

11/23/24 Hotel Rule – Children under the age of 17 must remain under direct supervision of a parent, guardian, or chaperone.

IMPORTANT!

<u>Supplemental Entry Form</u> and proof of foreign registration are **required** if you need to enter a dog using its Foreign Registry Number while you are waiting on a CKCSC number. Proof of foreign registration is any document that shows the foreign number is assigned to that dog. The application to register the individual dog or the litter **must have been received by the Registration Office** by late closing or the **entry will not be accepted**. If you have any questions or cannot download the form, please contact Beth Bales. (Refer to Show Rules Section II. Dogs, Rule 1.)

CONFIRMATION DATE IS MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025!

Entry confirmations will be sent on Monday, March 3, 2025. Please read your confirmation carefully and contact the Show Secretary with any changes immediately upon receipt. If you have not heard from the Show Secretary by this date, contact them immediately.

RINGSIDE READY REMINDER!

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog ringside for all competitions for which they are eligible, including dogs that are eligible to return to the ring for Reserve and Award of Merit competitions. The grooming area and hotel rooms are not ringside. Dogs that are not ringside and ready to enter when called to join the competition may not be allowed to enter the ring.

CLASS ELIGIBILITY UPDATES TO SHOW RULES

Ineligible Entries Can No Longer Move To Open

Effective July 1, 2024, ineligible entries in the catalog may no longer be moved to the Open Class. **Please review your confirmation** carefully to ensure that there are no mistakes made by you or the Show Secretary.

Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility Change After Closing

Effective July 1, 2024, if you enter your Cavalier in the Bred By Exhibitor Class and are not available to show your dog in that class after closing for the show, you may move the dog to Open for the remainder of the show weekend.

You must submit a Bred By Exhibitor Class Change Form to the Show Secretary or a Member of the On-site Show Rules Committee as described on the form. Form can be submitted any time after the closing date and 30 minutes prior to the start of all judging for the day.

You will not be allowed to show any dog in a Bred By Exhibitor Class for the remainder of the weekend.

Refer to Show Rule Section I. Owners and Exhibitors, Rule 13 for specifics. Fillable form is available on the event page.

Eligibility Change for Dogs With One Testicle

Effective 6/23/23, dogs who have had one testicle removed as a result of a necessary medical procedure are allowed to show. (Refer to Section II Dogs, Rule 6 for specifics.)

NEW! Major Points Update

The Schedule of Points has been updated to ensure that a Reserve Win is awarded more points than a Class Win. Additionally, the schedule has been adjusted to reduce the minimum number of dogs or bitches showing to receive the maximum number of Major Points. Refer to the website for the current schedule. <u>Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match</u> will be held immediately following the lunch break all three days. Puppies 3 - 4 months of age are eligible to compete. Puppy should be accustomed to a collar and lead or they may use a harness. This event is meant to be a good experience for the puppy rather than highly competitive. Puppy must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. Sign up at the show. **Entry fee is \$5.**

Friday Seminar "The Breed Standard" will be presented by Charlie Weidig, a CKCSC, USA, Judge and veteran educator with over 40 years of experience in the breed. The seminar will be of general interest to anyone who exhibits or breeds Cavaliers, or simply wants to learn more about what breeders, exhibitors, and judges are looking for. It will also satisfy the annual continuing education requirement for CKCSC, USA judges, and it is one of the required seminar topics for Candidate Judges. This is a **free** event. Light meal is provided.

The seminar will focus on the interpretation of all conformation aspects described in the Breed Standard, with graphical illustrations. In addition, there will be some discussion of how a judge can discern the degree of conformation to the Standard, comparisons to the UK and AKC Standards, and an opportunity to test your own knowledge of the Cavalier Breed Standard. Feel free to bring a Cavalier with you for a hands-on demonstration!

POSSIBLE MALE REPRODUCTIVE CLINIC

Lacey Rosenberg, DVM, DACT and her team from Veterinary Specialties at the Lake are considering offering a male reproductive clinic on Sunday, March 16, *if there is enough interest in these services*. Appointments would need to be pre-scheduled with a deposit for this clinic. Please contact Dr. Rosenberg's team via email at <u>reprovhl@gmail.com</u> OR via phone at 828-478-3500. If you are calling, please reference the COS Semen Freezing Clinic and ask for Jenn.

Requirements for semen collection include a current brucellosis test within 6 months, or a test can be run via a blood draw at the clinic for an additional fee (see below). It is strongly recommended that your dog be microchipped and have DNA on file with the AKC. These services can be provided at the clinic.

CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED FOR ENTRY FEES

Cavaliers of the South (COS) will accept credit cards for entry fees in addition to checks but will <u>not</u> be accepting any credit card information with your show entry. COS has switched to a completely different method done entirely with PayPal.

Enter your credit card number and amount into their secure website. No one sees or has access to your information. The payment goes directly into the Cavaliers of the South account at PayPal.

Do <u>NOT</u> submit any credit card information with your entries.

SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED VIA FAX AND EMAIL

CONFORMATION

As of 4/2/24

OFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(Championship Points awarded if entry justifies.)

Junior Puppy: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months.

Senior Puppy: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months.

Graduate Puppy: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

Novice: Dogs 5 months and older, never to have won any points at a CKCSC, USA, or CKCSC Regional Championship Show, nor a major win, nor a championship in any Registry in which the Breed is recognized.

Bred By Exhibitor: Dogs 5 months and older, owned by the breeder and handled in the ring by the breeder or his/her spouse or domestic partner. The breeder is the registered owner of the dam at the time of mating.

Junior American Bred : Dogs 5 months but not yet 18 months, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship if over 12 months of age.

<u>American Bred</u>: Dogs 18 months and older, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. <u>Second Generation American Bred</u>: Dogs 5 months and older which are American Bred and of which both sire and dam are American Bred, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. (Offered at the National Specialty, Members Club Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)

Health & Conformation: Dogs 5 years of age and older with an OFA certificate that shows and OFA registry number and states that the dog has no evidence of hip dysplasia after 2 years of age and is certified clear within 1 year of the postmark closing date for that show of the following diseases:
 1) Heart – by a board certified cardiologist; 2) Patellar Luxation – by a licensed veterinarian or via an OFA patella certificate; 3) Eyes – by CERF or by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist's exam sheet indicating that eyes are "normal". Copies of the 4 certificates must accompany the entry form for any dog entering this class.

<u>Special Limit Blenheim</u>: Blenheim dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. <u>Special Limit Tricolor</u>: Tricolor dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Ruby: Ruby dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Black & Tan: Black & Tan dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. Open: Dogs 5 months and older.

Senior Open: Dogs 7 years and older.

UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(No championship points awarded.)

Veteran: Dogs 7 years and older. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age. (Offered at the Regional Clubs shows only.)

Bronze Veteran: Dogs 7 years but not yet 9 years. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age. (Offered at the National Specialty, Elizabeth I. Spalding Memorial Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)

Silver Veteran: Dogs 9 years but not yet 11 years. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age. (Offered at the National Specialty, Elizabeth I. Spalding Memorial Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)

Gold Veteran: Dogs 11 years and older. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age. (Offered at the National Specialty, Elizabeth I. Spalding Memorial Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)

Stud Dog: Stud dogs to parade with 2 or more of their get from at least 2 different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership. Get must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of get only.

Brood Bitch: Brood bitches to parade with two or more of their produce from at least two different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership.

Produce must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of produce only. <u>Brace</u>: Two dogs 5 months or older, of the same color and in the same ownership but not necessarily of the same sex. Class to be judged on similarity and quality.

FINAL AND SPECIAL AWARDS

AWARDS

All official conformation classes are judged for dogs, then bitches. Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy competitions take place after judging concludes for that sex. Initial competition for Special Awards Best American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Blenheim, Tricolor, Ruby, and Black-and-Tan In Show is held after Best Puppy for that sex is awarded. Unofficial conformation classes, including Best Veteran In Show, are judged after the competition for Winners/Reserve Winners/Reserve Winners/Reserve Winners/Reserve Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy Bitch. The remaining Final and Special Awards follow the unofficial conformation classes.

FINAL AWARDS

(Championship points awarded if entry justifies.)

Winners (WD, WB) is awarded from the Class Winners.

Reserve Winners (RWD, RWB) is awarded from the remaining Class Winners and the second place dog to Winners.

Best Puppy (BPD, BPB) is awarded from all undefeated puppies under one year of age after Reserve Winners and AOM's are awarded.

Best In Show (BIS) is awarded from Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

Reserved Best In Show (RBIS) is awarded from the Opposite Sex Winners and the Reserve Winners to Best In Show.

Best Puppy In Show (BPIS) is awarded from the winners of Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy Bitch after Best In Show is awarded.

Award of Merit (AOM) is awarded after Reserve Winners from the remaining Class Winners and next placing dog to Reserve Winners or the first AOM winner. (Up to two AOM's are awarded to each sex at all National shows and every championship show during the Regional Annual General Meeting (AGM) weekend.)

SPECIAL AWARDS

(No championship points awarded.)

Best Veteran In Show (Regional Shows) is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Classes immediately following the Veteran Class competition. Best Veteran Dog In Show (National Shows) is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Dog Class Winners immediately following the Veteran Dog Class competition.

Best Veteran Bitch In Show (National Shows) is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Bitch Classes immediately following the Veteran Bitch Class competition.

Best Veteran In Show (National Shows) is awarded from the winners of the Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch.

Best Health and Conformation In Show is awarded from the winners of the Health and Conformation Classes immediately following the Best Black-and Tan In Show competition.

Special Awards: Awarded from eligible dogs from all of the classes. The definition for the Special Award is the same as the associated class definition. They must include:

- Best American Bred in Show
- Best Bred By Exhibitor In Show
- Best Blenheim In Show
- Best Tricolor In Show
- Best Ruby In Show
- Best Black-and-Tan In Show

(No Championship Points awarded.)

<u>Junior Puppy</u>: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title. <u>Senior Puppy</u>: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title. <u>Graduate Puppy</u>: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

ADULT SWEEPSTAKES As of 2/21/19

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Adult: Dogs 18 months but not yet 7 years and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES As of 2/21/19

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Bronze Veteran:	Dogs 7 years but not yet 9 years.
Silver Veteran:	Dogs 9 years but not yet 11 years.
Gold Veteran:	Dogs 11 years and over.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP As of 8/1/22

(To be judged on how well the dogs are handled, NOT on the dogs themselves.)

Pee Wee Class: Handlers 5 years but not yet 11 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. Handler is allowed to have an adult accompany them in the ring. All participants are awarded first place ribbons. Wins are not eligible for yearend awards.

<u>Junior Class</u>: Handlers 6 years but not yet 10 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. <u>Intermediate Class</u>: Handlers 10 years but not yet 14 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table. <u>Senior Class</u>: Handlers 14 years but not yet 18 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table.

CAVALIER KING CHARLES SPANIEL CLUB, USA, MATCH RULES as of 9/1/19

PEE WEE PUPPY

as of 9/1/19

(The term "Puppy" applies to both sexes unless otherwise specified.)

- 1. Where applicable, the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, (CKCSC, USA) "Procedure for Registration and Transfer of Dogs" and "Show Rules" will be followed.
- 2. CKCSC, USA, Members can show any Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy that is registered with or awaiting registration with the CKCSC, USA; has a Performance Event Number (PEN); or is ineligible for registration with the CKCSC, USA. Any non-member is welcome to enter their Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy.
- 3. No puppy may be entered under a Judge by whom it was bred or to whom it currently or has previously belonged, including coownerships.
- 4. <u>No</u> Championship Points shall be earned at Pee Wee Puppy Matches.
- 5. A single class will be offered for puppies at least three (3) months of age, but not yet five (5) months. Best Pee Wee Puppy will be awarded to the class winner. Puppies of the opposite sex to the winner will compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best Pee Wee Puppy. Critiques will be written for both winners.
- 6. Puppies must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. This is the owner's responsibility. By entering the competition, the owner acknowledges that the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, Inc., assumes no liability for any illness contracted by the puppy as a result of entering the competition.
- 7. A puppy may be shown on a collar and leash or harness.
