Judge Etiquette and Procedures Seminar, conducted by David Frederick, CKCSC-USA Judge, will occur at 6pm on Friday.

Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match will be held immediately following the lunch break all three days. Sign up at the show. Entry fee is \$5. (See Pee Wee Puppy Fun Match Rules in this premium for rules and eligibility.)

Heart and Eye Clinics are offered on Saturday starting at 9:00 am. Walk-ins will be accommodated. OFA forms for eyes and hearts are provided. **Fee is \$50 for each.**

The COS Annual Banquet Saturday night is a buffet and cash bar, starting at 7pm. Menu is Fried Chicken, Baked Rigroni, Mac and Cheese, steamed vegetables, salad, desert, water, coffee and tea. Cost is \$58.

After dinner, there will be a short **Q&A with Dr. Lacy Rosenberg** about the value to freezing the sperm of our stud dogs, followed by a live auction.

Semen Freezing Clinic with Lacey Rosenberg, DVM, DACT and her team from Veterinary Specialties at the Lake will be available on Sunday from 8am until 2pm for pre-reserved semen collections/cryopreservation (freezing). They will be providing limited services related to semen collection and freezing. No physical examinations/infertility workups can be done; however, you can schedule these services with Dr. Rosenberg at her office on a future date.

Dr. Rosenberg and her team will have limited spots available. Please contact them via email at drlaceyrosenberg@gmail.com OR via phone at 828-478-3500 to reserve your spot. When calling, please let them know it's in reference to the COS Semen Freezing Clinic and Ask for Jenn or Star. **A deposit of \$150 will be required to reserve your spot.** Other requirements include a current brucellosis test within 6 months, or a test can be run via a blood draw at the clinic for an additional fee (see below). It is also strongly recommended that your dog be microchipped and have DNA on file with the AKC. These services can be provided at the clinic.

Pricing is as follows:

- Semen collection, full evaluation, cryopreservation, and storage through end of 2023: \$500
- Semen collection and full evaluation without cryopreservation: \$150
- Semen collection, full evaluation, and 48-hour chill testing in 3 different extenders: \$250
- Brucellosis testing: \$75
- Pre-Paid DNA Swab/Kit for AKC DNA Registry: \$55
- Microchip implant: \$35

IMPORTANT!

Supplemental Entry Form and proof of foreign registration are **required** if you need to enter a dog using its Foreign Registry Number while you are waiting on a CKCSC number. Proof of foreign registration is any document that shows the foreign number is assigned to that dog. The application to register the individual dog or the litter **must have been received by the Registration Office** by late closing or the **entry will not be accepted**. If you have any questions or cannot download the form, please contact Beth Bales. (Refer to Show Rules Section II. Rule 1.)

RINGSIDE READY REMINDER!

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog ringside for all competitions for which they are eligible, including dogs that are eligible to return to the ring for Reserve and Award of Merit competitions. The grooming area and hotel rooms are not ringside. Dogs that are not ringside and ready to enter when called to join the competition may not be allowed to enter the ring. Because **Awards of Merit (AOM) are awarded at this show**, it is possible that third and even fourth place winners could return to compete for an AOM. (Refer to Show Rules Section I. Rule 21.)

NEW JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES!

Effective 8/1/22, Junior Showmanship now offers four (4) classes for our young handlers that allows them to compete with others closer to their age. Participants can select to participate in only one class. (Refer to Class Definitions – Junior Showmanship for detail definitions.)

To implement this change, the age ranges for the Junior and Senior Classes have been changed and two new classes are offered – Intermediate and Pee Wee Classes.

Pee Wee Class participants can be 5 years of age and not yet 11 years of age and are allowed to have an adult in the ring.

Wins in the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Classes count towards the Top Junior Showmanship Awards presented at the Annual Awards Banquet.

Regardless of the class entered, a young handler can switch between Pee Wee and age eligible classes on a given day but can participate in only one of the four classes on any given day.

CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED FOR ENTRY FEES

Cavaliers of the South (COS) will accept credit cards for entry fees in addition to checks but will not be accepting any credit card information with your show entry. COS has switched to a completely different method done entirely with PayPal.

- On the Summary of Amounts Due, check the line below TOTAL ALL ITEMS where prompted to indicate that you authorize COS to send you an invoice via PayPal. There is a \$10 convenience fee to use a credit card for payment.
- About a week before the show you will receive an email from service@paypal.com with subject Invoice from Cavaliers of the South. It will contain a link to your invoice.
- Click on the link in the email and you go directly to your PayPal invoice. The invoice will identify Cavaliers of the South and treasurer Neil Rosenberg. Enter your credit card number and amount into their secure website. No one sees or has access to your information. The payment goes directly into the Cavaliers of the South account at PayPal.
- Do NOT submit any credit card information with your entries.
- DO make sure that the email address on your show entry has the email address to which you wish the invoice to be sent.

SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED VIA FAX AND EMAIL

Cavaliers of the South (COS) will accept entries via email and fax in addition to postal mail under the following conditions. PLEASE read the instructions CAREFULLY. **Entries will not be accepted until payment is received.** DO NOT SEND ANY CREDIT CARD INFORMATION WITH YOUR ENTRIES.

1. Entries submitted by mail must include either a check or payment is assumed to be via PayPal. Entries postmarked after the postmark closing date are considered late entries subject to the late fee.
2. Entries submitted by fax must be received by the postmark closing date. If paying by check, the mailed check must be postmarked by the postmark closing date. If any of the above conditions are not met, the entries are considered late entries and subject to the late fee.
3. Entries submitted by email must be received by the postmark closing date. Checks that are mailed must be postmarked by postmark closing.

CAVALIER KING CHARLES SPANIEL CLUB, USA DEFINITION OF CLASSES

As of 9/1/22

The term "Dog" applies to both sexes unless otherwise specified.

CONFORMATION

As of 2/21/19

OFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(Championship Points awarded if entry justifies.)

Junior Puppy: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months.

Senior Puppy: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months.

Graduate Puppy: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

Novice: Dogs 5 months and older, never to have won any points at a CKCSC, USA, or CKCSC Regional Championship Show, nor a major win, nor a championship in any Registry in which the Breed is recognized.

Bred By Exhibitor: Dogs 5 months and older, owned by the breeder and handled in the ring by the breeder or his/her spouse or domestic partner. The breeder is the registered owner of the dam at the time of mating.

Junior American Bred: Dogs 5 months but not yet 18 months, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship if over 12 months of age.

American Bred: Dogs 18 months and older, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

Second Generation American Bred: Dogs 5 months and older which are American Bred and of which both sire and dam are American Bred, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. (Offered at the National Specialty, Members Club Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.)

Health & Conformation: Dogs 5 years of age and older with an OFA certificate that shows and OFA registry number and states that the dog has no evidence of hip dysplasia after 2 years of age and is certified clear within 1 year of the postmark closing date for that show of the following diseases: 1) Heart – by a board certified cardiologist; 2) Patellar Luxation – by a licensed veterinarian or via an OFA patella certificate; 3) Eyes – by CERF or by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist's exam sheet indicating that eyes are "normal". Copies of the 4 certificates must accompany the entry form for any dog entering this class.

Special Limit Blenheim: Blenheim dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Tricolor: Tricolor dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Ruby: Ruby dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Special Limit Black & Tan: Black & Tan dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age.

Open: Dogs 5 months and older.

Senior Open: Dogs 7 years and older.

UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

(No championship points awarded.)

Veteran: Dogs 7 years and older. Class to be judged on overall quality and conformation of the dogs, regardless of their age.

Stud Dog: Stud dogs to parade with 2 or more of their get from at least 2 different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership. Get must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of get only.

Brood Bitch: Brood bitches to parade with two or more of their produce from at least two different litters, not necessarily in the same ownership.

Produce must be entered in an Official or Unofficial Conformation Class at this Show. Class to be judged on quality and consistency of produce only.

Brace: Two dogs 5 months or older, of the same color and in the same ownership but not necessarily of the same sex. Class to be judged on similarity and quality.

FINAL AND SPECIAL AWARDS

AWARDS

All official conformation classes are judged for dogs, then bitches. Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy competitions take place after judging concludes for that sex. Initial competition for Special Awards Best American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Blenheim, Tricolor, Ruby, and Black-and-Tan In Show is held after Best Puppy for that sex is awarded. Unofficial conformation classes, including Best Veteran In Show, are judged after the competition for Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy Bitch. The remaining Final and Special Awards follow the unofficial conformation classes.

FINAL AWARDS

(Championship points awarded if entry justifies.)

Winners (WD, WB) is awarded from the Class Winners.

Reserve Winners (RWD, RWB) is awarded from the remaining Class Winners and the second place dog to Winners.

Best Puppy (BPD, BPB) is awarded from all undefeated puppies under one year of age after Reserve Winners and AOM's are awarded.

Best In Show (BIS) is awarded from Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

Reserved Best In Show (RBIS) is awarded from the Opposite Sex Winners and the Reserve Winners to Best In Show.

Best Puppy In Show (BPIS) is awarded from the winners of Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy Bitch after Best In Show is awarded.

Award of Merit (AOM) is awarded after Reserve Winners from the remaining Class Winners and next placing dog to Reserve Winners or the first AOM winner. (Up to two AOM's are awarded to each sex at all National shows and every championship show during the Regional Annual General Meeting (AGM) weekend.)

SPECIAL AWARDS

(No championship points awarded.)

Best Veteran In Show is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Classes immediately following the Veteran Class competition.

Best Health and Conformation In Show is awarded from the winners of the Health and Conformation Classes immediately following the Best Black-and-Tan In Show competition.

Special Awards: Awarded from eligible dogs from all of the classes. The definition for the Special Award is the same as the associated class definition. They must include:

- Best American Bred in Show
- Best Bred By Exhibitor In Show
- Best Blenheim In Show
- Best Tricolor In Show
- Best Ruby In Show
- Best Black-and-Tan In Show

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Junior Puppy: Puppies 5 months but not yet 9 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title.

Senior Puppy: Puppies 9 months but not yet 12 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title.

Graduate Puppy: Dogs 12 months but not yet 18 months and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title.

ADULT SWEEPSTAKES

As of 2/21/19.

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Adult: Dogs 18 months but not yet 7 years and not holding a CKCSC, USA, championship title.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

As of 2/21/19.

(No Championship Points awarded.)

Bronze Veteran: Dogs 7 years but not yet 9 years.

Silver Veteran: Dogs 9 years but not yet 11 years.

Gold Veteran: Dogs 11 years and over.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

(To be judged on how well the dogs are handled, NOT on the dogs themselves.)

As of 8/1/22.

Pee Wee Class: Handlers 5 years but not yet 11 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table. Handler is allowed to have an adult accompany them in the ring. All participants are awarded first place ribbons. Wins are not eligible for yearend awards.

Junior Class: Handlers 6 years but not yet 10 years. Dogs not to be placed upon the examining table.

Intermediate Class: Handlers 10 years but not yet 14 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table.

Senior Class: Handlers 14 years but not yet 18 years. Dogs to be placed upon examining table.

CAVALIER KING CHARLES SPANIEL CLUB, USA, MATCH RULES

PEE WEE PUPPY

as of 9/1/19

(The term "Puppy" applies to both sexes unless otherwise specified.)

1. Where applicable, the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, (CKCSC, USA) "Procedure for Registration and Transfer of Dogs" and "Show Rules" will be followed.
2. CKCSC, USA, Members can show any Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy that is registered with or awaiting registration with the CKCSC, USA; has a Performance Event Number (PEN); or is ineligible for registration with the CKCSC, USA. Any non-member is welcome to enter their Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy.
3. No puppy may be entered under a Judge by whom it was bred or to whom it currently or has previously belonged, including co-ownerships.
4. No Championship Points shall be earned at Pee Wee Puppy Matches.
5. A single class will be offered for puppies at least three (3) months of age, but not yet five (5) months. Best Pee Wee Puppy will be awarded to the class winner. Puppies of the opposite sex to the winner will compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best Pee Wee Puppy. Critiques will be written for both winners.
6. Puppies must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. This is the owner's responsibility. By entering the competition, the owner acknowledges that the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, Inc., assumes no liability for any illness contracted by the puppy as a result of entering the competition.
7. A puppy may be shown on a collar and leash or harness.
